Special Events Descriptions:

Fashion Walk: A great way to show off your talents. Each participant will wear a handmade item(s) and show it off as they parade the fashion walk. Each item must be accompanied by a 3x5 index card listing who the maker is, what the item(s) are, what they are made of and how it was constructed (i.e.: hand woven, knitted, felted, ect.). If you are selling these items, please note that on your index card so the announcer can relay that information and direct inquires to you.

Super Silly Spinning Challenge: A just-for-fun contest with prizes awarded for the longest yarn spun. Two categories will be offered: spinning wheel and drop spindle. You provide the spinning device, the skill and the courage, and we'll provide the fiber, rubber gloves and blind fold.

Here's the challenge:

1. Spin 30 seconds normally.
2. Spin 30 seconds wearing rubber gloves.
3. Spin 30 seconds while blindfolded (but no gloves).

Relay Knitting Challenge: A team of four knitters will be set up. We will provide needles, yarn and a cast-on row. Team members will then knit two minutes, as fast as they can, in garter stitch. When the timer rings, the member "passes the baton (needles)" to the next team member. At the end of the relay, the team with the most number of rows wins a prize.
