

SAFONA Fall Classic Alpaca Show
October 1 & 2, 2011 – Kutztown Fairgrounds
225 North Whiteoak Street, Kutztown, PA 19530

Show Rules for Exhibitors and Vendors:

Exhibitors' entry fees are \$65.00 per alpaca for SAFONA members and \$75.00 per alpaca for non-members. There is a limit of 6 alpacas/3 stalls per breeder. You must bring your own pen panels; maximum size is 10' x 10'. Entry fee covers all classes for each eligible alpaca.

Vendor fees are \$25.00 for SAFONA members and \$35.00 for non-members. Each vendor space will be 10' x 10' and each vendor must bring their own tables and chairs.

Registration will close September 17, 2011 or when the 128 alpaca limit has been filled. Late entries will not be accepted.

All alpacas must be ARI registered. All alpacas being registered for classes must have a copy of the alpaca's ARI certificate. Entry forms signed by someone other than the owner listed on the ARI certificate must include a signed and dated SAFONA Permission to Show form. *AOBA Permission to Show forms will not be accepted.* Companion alpacas must be ARI registered, micro-chipped and vet checked with health papers submitted to vet at check-in.

Pending registrations **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**

Fee for substitutions is \$30.00 each before closing. No substitutions or refunds will be allowed/given after registration closes!

No stall fees will be charged. Exhibitors must bring their own panels. Maximum of three (3) pens will be allowed per exhibitor. You may use one pen space for your farm display and two (2) pens for alpacas if you want to set up a farm display. Each exhibitor is encouraged to sell their own alpaca fiber, roving, yarns and garments. All items must be kept within pen spaces and not out in the aisles.

Stall will be on macadam, under roof of pole barns. Each exhibitor is REQUIRED to bring their own bedding (straw, mats, etc.) and hay. **EACH EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO REMOVE THEIR BEDDING AND MANURE AND STALL AREAS ARE TO BE CLEANED BEFORE DEPARTURE!** Bedding and manure should be put in trash bags and thrown in dumpsters provided. Trash bags will be provided. *This year, SAFONA is offering the option for the Berks Co. 4H group "Camelid Characters" to clean up your stalls for the price of \$10.00.*

No alpacas and no sales of alpacas under the age of six (6) months will be allowed at the show.

Water is available on the fairgrounds. Electricity is available at a cost of \$15.00 per exhibitor and vendor. Food will be available at the show grounds.

Lodging will be provided by Hawthorn Suites LTD, 7720 Main Street, Fogelsville, PA 18051. (610) 366-9422. The cost is \$79.00/night for king; \$89.00/night for double plus tax. Room reservations must be made by 9/2/10 to ensure the SAFONA group rates. Use booking code SAF when registering.

Small motor homes are permitted to stay at the fairgrounds at a cost of \$25.00 a night (Fairground rules not SAFONA's). There are no hook-ups available. Restrooms will be left unlocked for anyone staying on the fairgrounds at night.

Security will be available on the fairgrounds. Anyone entering, leaving or staying on the grounds Friday and Saturday night from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m. must have their Entrance and Parking permit. Anyone caught not having this will be escorted off by security guards.

A veterinarian will be on the premises to check health certificates and will be available for alpaca health emergencies. Anyone requiring veterinarian assistance will be responsible for their own fees incurred.

Age Division for Alpacas:

All alpacas entered in the shows and for sale must be at least six (6) months of age at time of the first day of the show.

Juveniles: born on or between 10/02/10 & 04/02/11.

Yearlings: born between 10/02/09 & 09/30/10.

Adults (2 or more years of age): born on 10/01/09 or before.

NOTE: All alpacas must be micro chipped, vaccinated for rabies, and be negative PCR or VI for BVDV. A negative BVDV PCR or VI test and results must be noted on the CVI. A copy of the BVDV PCR or VI test must also be provided. See additional PA state veterinary requirements under "Health Requirements".
